7.1 Premier Club Division:

Bristol finished 11th on 66.86 points Exe-Calibre finished 12th on 65 points

Standard Club Division:

Preston finished 1st on 129.5 points Cambridgeshire Royals finished 2nd on 80.4 points.

Preston & Cambridge are promoted to Premier Club Division.

Bristol & Exe-Calibre are relegated to Standard Club Division.

NP proposed changes to Premier & Standard Club scores. You only get your top 2 scores for the league.

CB has also done an analysis on clubs and gender mix and what the crew's look like:

Poss looking at options of:

Mainly Women Boats – 14 women/6 men Mainly Men Boats – 14 men/6 women Mixed Boats – 10 men / 10 women Some positives and negatives around this. Would need some careful thinking and the ramifications around how it would work. Would it give people more racing and equal racing?

Events for 2020

Bids have come in for 2020. We want to start bid process for 2021 by Jan 2020.

Need to ensure we have a sensible number of clubs at each event.

Discussion around number of races and what is mandatory for clubs.

Possibility of looking at mandatory racing for north clubs and mandatory for southern clubs. 6 races from 8 count for league points – clubs decide which 6 to attend.
